

Thank you for being in touch and we apologize for this “standard answer” letter. We would be pleased to carry your book(s) at the 2017 BoucherCon, however there is some information you need to be aware of as the publishing industry works a little differently in Canada.

Shipping charges are considerable and return options are not all the same so you, the author, need to know who distributes your book(s) in Canada. Who distributes your book(s) in Canada will determine whether we get your book(s) from the distributor directly (Group A) or expect you to bring stock of your book(s) to us on a consignment basis (Group B).

In the former case (Group A) you need do nothing. We’ll order stock, and deal with the returns.

In the latter case (Group B), including self-published books, Print on Demand books and books from US distributors such as Ingram and Baker and Taylor, or UK distributors such as Bertram and Gardners, you will need to bring stock of your book(s) to our tables in the dealers’ room, priced in Canadian dollars. We will sell them on your behalf for a 40% commission.

If you are Group B, you must come by and collect the unsold consigned stock before the end of the BoucherCon. We will settle up with you at that point. All transactions are in Canadian Dollars and all uncollected books will be considered abandoned. **We will not ship them back to you.**

If your book(s) is/are in the Group B category please fill in the consignment form attached (a copy also follows at the end of this email) and bring it and your books, to the Sleuth of Baker Street tables when you get to BoucherCon. If possible, please see us Wednesday afternoon or Thursday morning.

We appreciate that this may be different than US BoucherCons, but, ces’t la vie in Canada. As the Group A list may not be exhaustive by all means contact us (sleuth@sleuthofbakerstreet.ca). We can help sort out whether you are in Group A or B and try to answer your questions.
